Q1 renews an existing operating levy, Q2 reinvests in a phased-in increase to the operating levy.

## Vote early by mail

Absentee ballot applications are available in school offices or online at www.mnvotes.org. Printed absentee ballot applications should be mailed to:

Once you complete and submit the application, you will receive a ballot by mail with instructions for returning it. Be sure to allow ample time for your ballot to be mailed to you, and for you to mail your ballot back before November 3.
